Stop and make the meaning of
the text clear so you
understand.



During Reading

Context Clues

Use words and sentences
surrounding an unknown word to
determine its meaning.

During Reading

Evaluate

Make opinions and judgments to
develop ideas from reading.



During & After Reading

Fix-Up

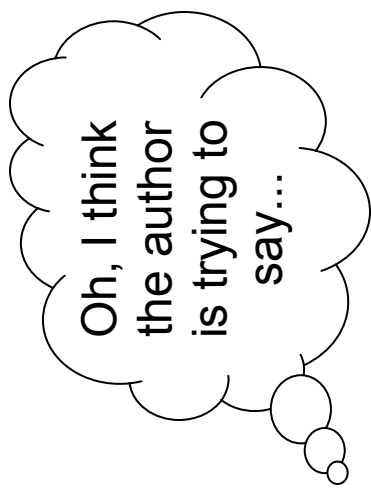
Self-monitor to check for understanding. If you do not understand, do something to fix it.



During Reading

Infer

Make a logical guess based on
the facts or evidence
presented.



During & After Reading

Key Vocabulary

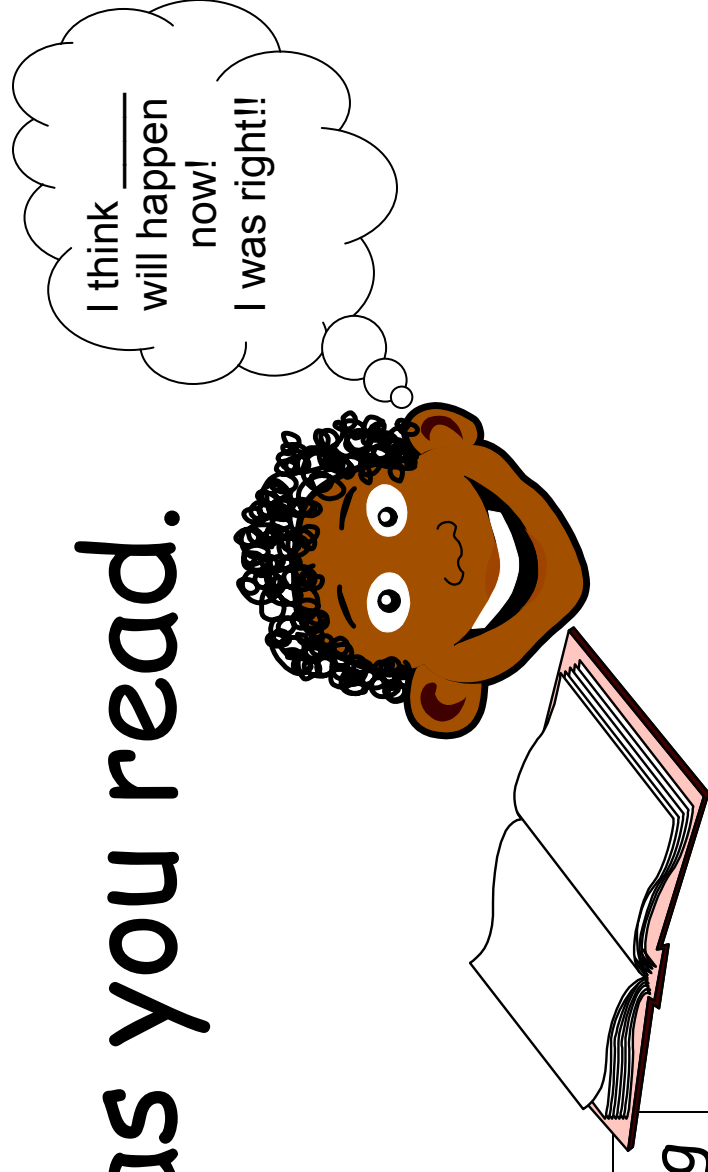
Identify the important words to help you determine the main ideas of the text.

Before & During Reading

Predict

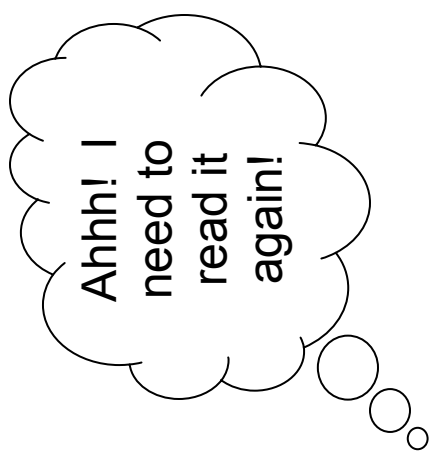
Use the text to decide what
will happen next. Confirm your
predictions as you read.

Reread

Reread parts or all of the text
to better understand.

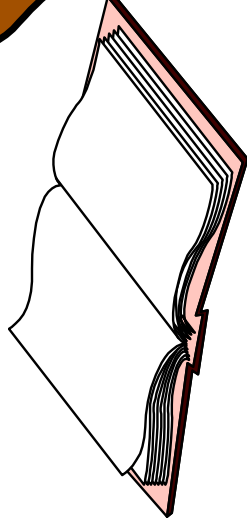
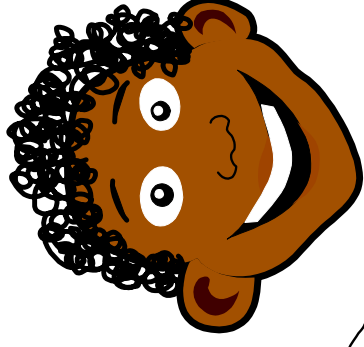
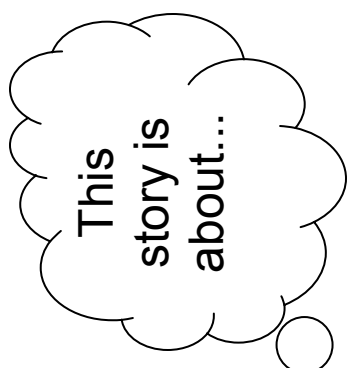


During Reading

Restate

Retell, shorten or summarize

the meaning of a text.

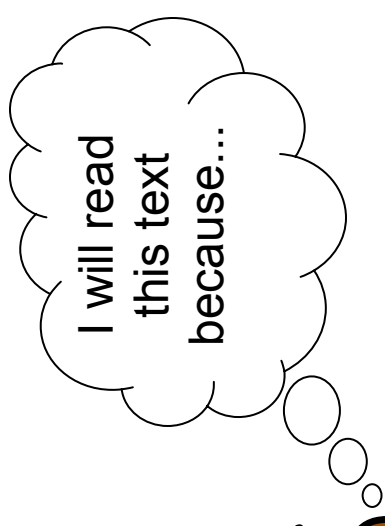


During Reading

Set a Purpose

Decide your reason for reading

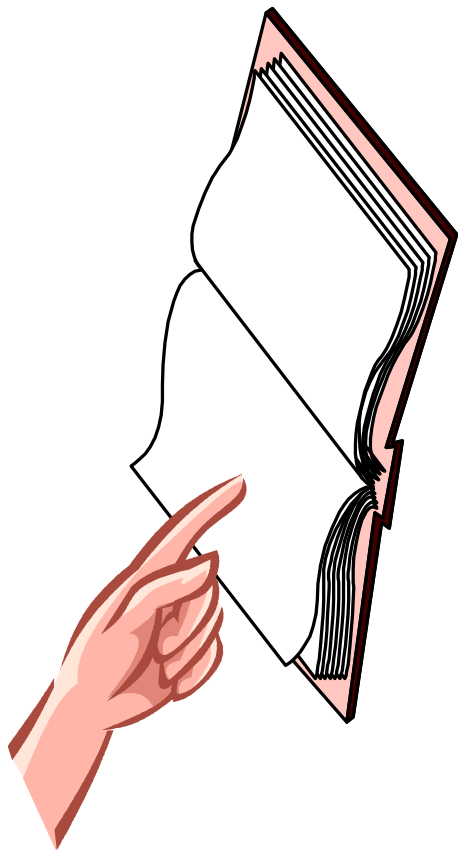
a text.



Pre-Reading

Scan

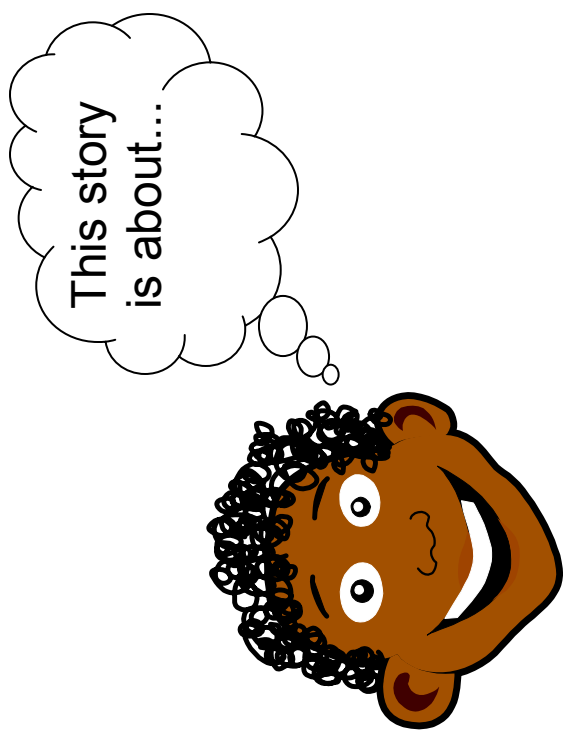
Quickly search parts or all of the text to find specific information.



Pre-, During & After Reading

Summarize

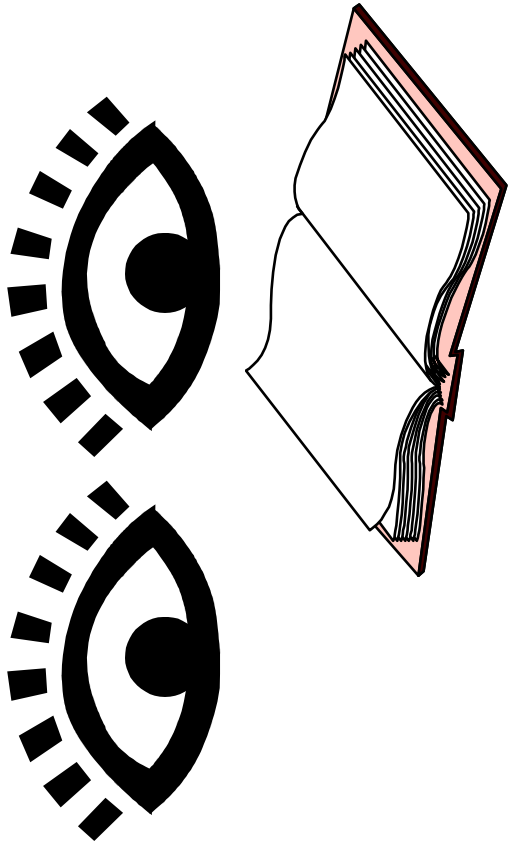
Organize and restate the main ideas of the text.



During & After Reading

Survey/Preview

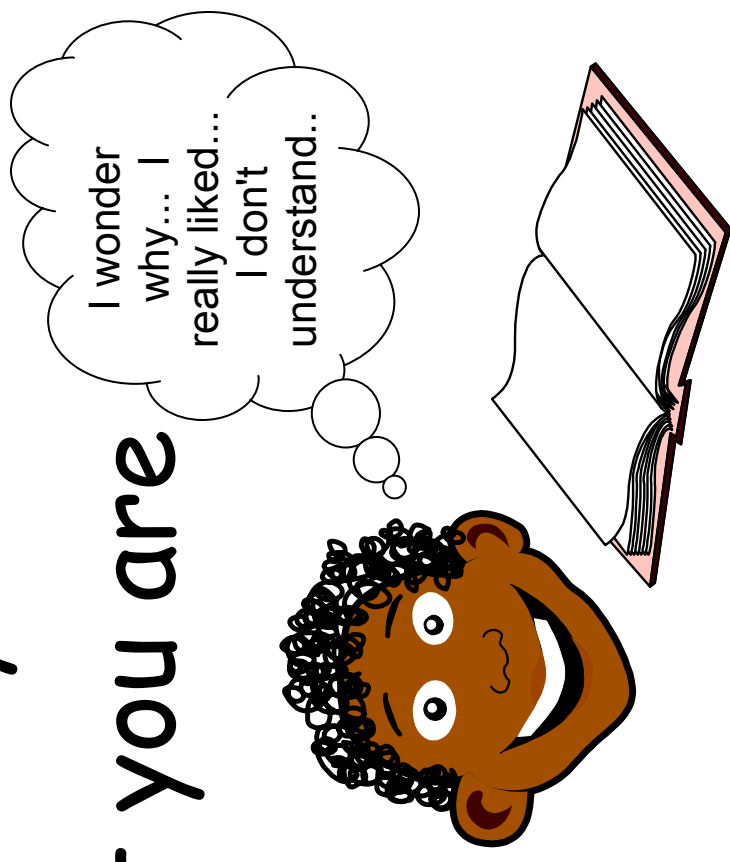
Look over the text to get a
general idea of what you will
read.



Pre-Reading

Think Aloud

Have a **conversation** about what you
think of the text, what you
understand and what you are
confused about.



Pre-, During & After Reading

Visualize

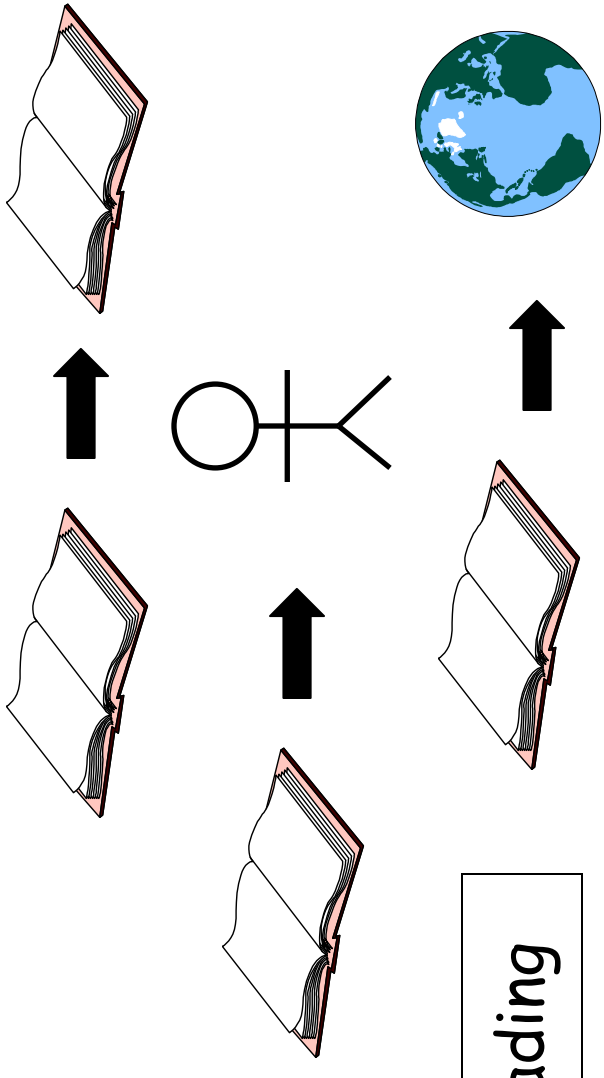
Use **mental images** from reading
the text to help **understanding**.



During Reading

Make Connections

Find similarities and differences between many texts, between the text and you and between the text and the world.



Pre-, During & After Reading

Highlight

Highlight, underline or post-it important parts of the text.

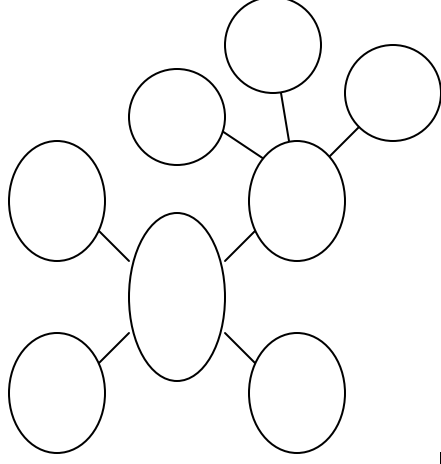
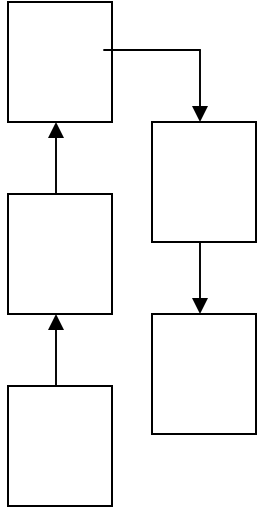
During World War II, over 6 million Jews were murdered.

During Reading

Take Notes

Take notes in a variety of ways (outline, flowchart, semantic mapping, etc.) to organize important

information.
